Project Description

Kellet Bluff is located at the SW tip of Henry Island, a small non-ferry served island just off the NW side of San Juan Island. The Hart property encompasses roughly 80 acres with shoreline on both the Haro Strait (over 1,500 feet) and Open Bay (nearly 1,400 feet). The Haro strait shoreline is rocky with extensive nearshore kelpbeds and two cormorant rookeries. The property hasseveral pocket beaches with overhanging vegetation and nearshore eelgrass beds on the Open Bay side. Additionally, Orcas frequent the area around the intertidal rocks of this shoreline. This is one of the highest priority areas for salmon recovery in the San Juans due to concentration of juvenile Chinook and existing protected shorelines and undeveloped properties. WRIA 2 has designated protection of habitat as the highest priority action for the area.
