Planning Questions	<p>Please answer questions for all restoration areas -- if more than the city marsh property is part of the scope.</p> <p>RCO may have an exemption from GEO 05-05 consultation by the time your cultural resources assessment is complete. If a project will be subject to a Corps permit, Section 106 prevails. As long as the geotech work (and other ground disturbing activities required for the design work) is observed by an archaeologist and results incorporated into the assessment -- we may be able to hold off on the 05-05 consultation until the corps permit process begins. RCO and DAHP are negotiating the interagency agreement now -- should be complete by fall.</p>
