Agreement Description

The work plan for the Asotin IMW will include the following services provided by WDFW:

- 1. Coordinate juvenile fish tagging in the summer (July) and fall (Sept/Oct); manage crew of 3-6 people and gear
- 2. Provide two technicians to assist in stream habitat sampling mostly from mid July to late September. The crew may be required to attend CHaMP training in early June
- 3. Monitor and maintain as needed the Array Infrastructure in Asotin Creek; any new equipment will be purchased with IMW funds if available
- 4. Assist in other IMW tasks as needed and agreed upon, including restoration, temperature and discharge monitoring, mobile fish surveys, etc.
