Special Conditions

- 1. On July 1, 2007, the name of the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation changed to the Recreation and Conservation Funding Board and the office name changed to the Recreation and Conservation Office. The General Provisions of the Project Agreement do not reflect this change. To allow immediate implementation of this project, the existing provisions are hereby incorporated into the agreement. All references to the Board refer to the Recreation and Conservation Funding Board. References to the Office refer the Recreation and Conservation Office.
- 2. Before reimbursement of any development related expenses, the sponsor must comply with Governor's Executive Order 05-05 regarding Archeological and Cultural Resources for the scope of work approved in this Project Agreement. The Recreation and Conservation Office will issue a notice to proceed when appropriate documentation has been received.

In the event that archaeological or historic materials are discovered during project activities, work in the immediate vicinity must stop; the area must be secured, and the Sponsor must notify the concerned tribe's cultural staff and cultural committee, the Recreation and Conservation Office, and Department of Archaeology and Historic Preservation.

- 3. The Dugualla Bay Preserve, with Island County Assessor's Tax I.D. Numbers: R23317-511-2140; R23317-521-1800; R23317-527-2670; R23317-506-3460; and R23317-450-2020, was acquired with Washington Salmon Recovery Funding Board (WSRFB) grant funds on December 23, 2009. The WSRFB Deed of Right (DOR) encumbrance was recorded on the title on June 8, 2011, Island County Auditor's Recording Number 4296265.
 - A Notice of Grant Agreement encumbrance, for the North American Wetlands Conservation Act (NAWCA) grant program, administered by the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service (USFWS), may be recorded on the title of property acquired by the Whidbey Camano Land Trust. This USFWS Notice of Grant Agreement encumbrance is subordinate to WSRFB's DOR. Any future conversion of the above described property, as outlined in the DOR, must be valued without the DOR and USFWS encumbrance on the title.
- 4. The Dugualla Bay Preserve, with Island County Assessor's Tax I.D. Number: R23318-473-1010, was acquired with Washington Salmon Recovery Funding Board (WSRFB) grant funds on December 16, 2009. The WSRFB Deed of Right (DOR) encumbrance was recorded on the title on June 8, 2011, Island County Auditor's Recording Number 4296265.
 - A Declaration of Covenant, on behalf of the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) for the purposes of wetland mitigation for its SR 532 Davis Slough Bridge Replacement project, may be recorded on the title of property acquired by the Whidbey Camano Land Trust. This Declaration of Covenant encumbrance is subordinate to WSRFB's DOR. Any future conversion of the above described property, as outlined in the DOR, must be valued without the DOR and WSDOT encumbrance on the title.
