Amendment Description:

Due to changing circumstances with both project landowners (Ried and Little Bit) a scope change is requested to remove the Ried easement from the project, and change the Little Bit easement to fee acquisition of the original easement footprint. Also correcting stream mile metric, which was originally calculated as stream bank miles not stream miles, and will subsequently be reduced due to loss of one landowner. Match % will not change nor will incidental costs (substantially). Return funds up to \$45,000 are likely.
