# AMENDMENT TO STAFF REPORT & DECISION SHORELINE EXEMPTION— TYPE I 183/16 SHE — SEAHORSE SIESTA CLUB REMOVE EXISTING BARGE/BULKHEAD & RESTORE NEARSHORE HABITAT

#### I – AMENDMENT

The approval for Shoreline Exemption 183/16 SHE is hereby amended to authorize the removal of the existing barge, bulkhead and fill with the amended proposal to include two proposed drift sills (projecting approximately 11ft and 16ft from the toe of the slope) with the addition of beach nourishment. The original proposal that was approved included 65ft of structural stabilization (rockery wall). The amended design does not include the hard armoring of a rockery wall and the proposed drift cell structures will provide better protection for the beach access path, reduce bluff erosion and will preserve the existing shore form.

This amendment does not modify any findings or Conditions of Approval contained within 183/16 SHE. Any further modifications may require a new shoreline permit.

### II - APPEALS

Island County Code does not contain a provision for administrative appeal of Type I permits if approved. Any challenge to permit conditions sought by the applicant may be filed under Washington's Land Use Petition Act (LUPA), Chapter 36.70C RCW.


