Questions

#1: Are there any significant challenges that might hinder progress or keep you from meeting your project milestones? If so, please tell us about them.

Yes

Significant design changes were request by the Muckleshoot tribe. We have done our best to incorporate as many of Muckleshoot comments as possible. However, do to liability concerns were are unable to incorporate all of the requested design changes. The USACE and WDFW permits were submitted prior to the requested design revisions. The revised designs will need to be submitted to permitting agencies which will likely result in permitting delays. I do not know how significant these delays will be. However, I do think we have enough time before the 2020 instream work window to secure permits and constructed this summer.

#2: Describe the work accomplished during this reporting period.

During this reporting period a project cost increase was prepared and submitted to RCO. Project permits were applied for and comments from the City of Redmond, WDFW and Muckleshoot tribes were received and responded too (See Basis of Design Report). WDFW requested a site visit to better understand the project and requested a few specification be more clearly defined in the designs, such as the fish mix specs. City of Redmond had comments that I and Jay the project engineer answered via email. Tom Hardy from the City of Redmond also attended a site visit to better understand the project and he requested that we lower the floodplain elevation to better accommodate out-migrating smolts. By far the Muckleshoot tribe had the most significant design changes request, some of there comments are as follows: No or significantly reduce LWD anchoring, no need to dig scour pools let the wood do the digging, let the wood migrate downstream, more dynamic is better, etc. The revised designs incorporate many of these comments. Design revision were complete and the associated revision to the design report.

#3: Tell us about work planned for the next reporting period

For the next reporting period I plan to secure all project permits HPA, USACE, Flood Hazard. In addition, we will complete riparian restoration design, begin construction preparations, stock piling materials onsite, setting up the construction schedule, ordering supplies and reserving rental equipment. I will also be coordinating with and archaeologist to monitor the site during construction, as required. I am waiting to hear back from the Muckleshoot tribes on if they can provide an archaeologist to monitor the project site.

The lead federal agency should be able to provide you the necessary documentation.

b) Design Deliverables: The project will meet the standards for Design and Restoration Project Deliverables described in Manual 18 (2018) Appendix D-4 Construction Deliverables. The preliminary designs were submitted as part of the SRFB grant application process and are attached to PRISM. The sponsor submitted draft final designs to the WRIA 8 Technical Committee for review, and recommendations were incorporated into the final designs which are attached to PRISM. The sponsor will submit As-built Drawings upon completion of the restoration project.
