- We are making substantial progress towards our construction start: Secured preliminary approval from RCO Compliance Specialist to record a BNSF maintenance
- easement on the park property, subject to RCO review of final easement
- Provided RCO with additional submittal materials for 2018 LWCF grant.
- Learned that ESRP has fully funded the project.
- Received NEPA Categorical Exemption from Federal Rail Administration.
- Consultant team and Parks worked with WDFW staff to address issues/concerns on DRAFT Hydraulic
- Project Approval.
- Completed 1st DRAFT of Underpass Agreement and submitted to BNSF for review.
- Submitted legal descriptions for permanent and temporary construction easements for/from BNSF/County to BNSF for review.
- Procured appraisal services for easements
- Provided County review comments on 90% submittal to County Consultants.
- Sent Draft Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (UTC) Petition to BNSF for signature.
- Presented status update to Snohomish County Marine Resources Committee
- #2: Are there any significant challenges that might hinder progress or keep you from meeting your project milestones? If so, please tell us about them.

While we missed two milestones this period (Permits Complete by 3/31/20 and Plans/Specs to RCO by 6/30) in part due to limited staff resources and due to COVID-19 pandemic. We also had a slight shift in priorities, as NOAA invited us to apply for a \$300,000 habitat restoration grant which they are recommending for funding.

#3: Tell us about work planned for the next reporting period.

Completion of 100% plans, specs and estimate (Bid package); submittal of plans and specs to RCO; submittal of draft BNSF agreement for comment to RCO (waiting on first draft round with BNSF); submission and approval of UTC Petition. Submittal for Construction Stormwater Permit through Ecology, receipt of final remaining permits; submission and approval of final plans and specs by BNSF; execution of Underpass Agreement; project out to bid.

Additional funds became available from ESRP (\$50,000) in February and RCO is working on providing final information to procure LWCF funds (\$500,000). Snohomish County is hoping these awards can be added to current agreement with a cost increase amendment.

Special Conditions

Matching Funds

1) This Meadowdale Beach Park Estuary Restoration Project Agreement merges the following:

a) Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife awarded \$950,000 of Estuary and Salmon Restoration Program (ESRP) funds to the *Meadowdale Beach Park & Estuary Restoration Project - ESRP* (18-1587). The minimum match required for ESRP is 30% of the total project cost which is \$407,143 and can be met by a portion of the \$500,000 ALEA grant.

b) Recreation and Conservation Funding Board awarded \$500,000 of Aquatic Land Enhancement Account (ALEA) funds to *Meadowdale Beach Park & Estuary Restoration* (18-1504). The project application included a total of \$2,389,394 in match from a pending ESRP grant, a pending Salmon grant (18-1259), and Snohomish County Cash/Appropriation. SRFB and ESRP funding awards reduce the required ALEA Sponsor Match to \$639.394.

2) Total Sponsor Match will be \$704,713 (\$639.394 for ALEA + \$65,319 for SRFB).

3) ALEA funding requires at least \$295,472 of local match be sourced from non-state non-federal sources, which represents at least 10% of this total Project Agreement amount.
