### Questions

#1: Describe the work accomplished during this reporting period.

Entered into contract with Quilceda Excavation Inc to implement construction phase. QEI mobilized to site on October 29, 2020 and worked through November 7, 2020. QEI grubbed the site, began removing fill and wood from the barge area, and demoed a small portion of the barge wall to allow for construction access. The project experienced significant delays starting on November 8. Work resumed January 12th, but weather delays also occurred slowing progress.

Forage fish surveys were conducted every two weeks when work would be conducted on the beach.

Three surveys have been conducted - no eggs have been detected.

Delays were caused by a lack of an adequate landing site for the construction barge. It was also determined in the first week of work that the volume of material that may require export was grossly underestimated during the design phase. NWSF worked with the contractor to retest the fill sediments to determine if they could be placed on the beach rather than exported to save on some of the additional expenses. While this was allowed, the material would need to be sifted to separate wood debris from beach sediment therefore the cost savings were limited.

NWSF coordinated with funders at RCO and others to identify funds to support the cost increases.

#2: Are there any significant challenges that might hinder progress or keep you from meeting your project milestones? If so, please tell us about them.

Delays noted above have slowed the project. Vegetation installation will be delayed until March. Funding is limited to complete the project as additional sediment and debris needing export keep materializing within the structure.

Continue construction: remove fill for export; place beach materials and beach nourishment; build sills and stairs; regrade slope; support storm water drain; vegetate exposed slopes.

#### **Special Conditions**

- 1 The SRFB technical review panel requests that the rock wall and stair access be minimized to the extent possible in terms of the length of shoreline. Further, the panel emphasizes that the rock wall is not intended to stabilize the slope above and will not likely prevent movement of the path surface.
- 2 This contract includes \$46,815 of ESRP funds that were approved through project 18-2062 during ESRP's 2018 grant round and were merged into this contract via Amendment #1. Only \$43,565 of ESRP funds may be used as match for PSAR since the remaining \$3,250 of ESRP funds are for monitoring work. Monitoring expenses are not eligible to be reimbursed from PSAR funds and are not eligible as match. Note that indirect costs are not eligible to be reimbursed from ESRP funds.
- 3 PSAR funds must be expended by 6/30/2021.
