#2: Describe the work accomplished during this reporting period.

Procured materials lab, railroad, geotechnical, park/habitat consultants to assist with construction management. Project was advertised for bid on February 1, 2021 with bids opened on March 16, 2021. Snohomish County Council awarded the construction contract to Strider Construction on March 31, 2021. The Underpass Agreement between Snohomish County and BNSF was fully executed 6/14/21. Pre-construction conference with Strider Construction was held June 14, 2021 with Notice to Proceed issued on 6/15. Notified Permit Agencies and Tribes of construction start. Park closure notices and project signage installed. ESC bmp's installed, stripping, clearing and grubbing is near complete, demo of park features within estuary footprint (restroom enclosure, grills, picnic tables and concrete slabs, grating over the creek within the tunnel). Trees located outside BNSF right-of-way and the OHWM identified on the plans to be removed have been removed and stockpiled as LWD or Snags. Demolition, clearing, slab removal activities were performed under the observation of the County Archaeologist. Staff gauges with transducers were placed in the stream at 2 locations along with a third installed for atmospheric correction. Data collected for full tidal cycle will be used to generate pre-existing hydrograph per Monitoring Requirements. A stream survey to collect bibi, temperature and other data was conducted by Snohomish County Surface Water Management. A small "ground-breaking" ceremony is planned for mid-July, funding will be acknowledged. There are plans to complete a in lieu of all attending a "ground-breaking" ceremony. The Communications Specialist will reach out to RCO.

#4: Tell us about work planned for the next reporting period.

A pre-con with BNSF will be held on July 2, 2021. The Easement (Exhibit B/B-1 of the Underpass Agreement) across the BNSF right-of-way will be executed by July 15. De-fishing and installation of the stream bypass will occur in creek (freshwater fish window) July 1, Debris excavation, estuary excavation, beach grading after July 15th (marine fish window). All aspects of railroad bridge constructed by BNSF and Strider Construction anticipated to complete by September 30th. All estuary substrates will be placed; planting and irrigation installed in October. Winter shutdown anticipated Nov through March. Park anticipated to be re-opened during shutdown.

Special Conditions

A. Matching Funds

- 1) This Meadowdale Beach Park Estuary Restoration Project Agreement merges multiple grants. (See the January 2021 Updated Match Worksheet for details.)
- a) Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife awarded \$1,000,000 of Estuary and Salmon Restoration Program (ESRP) funds to the *Meadowdale Beach Park & Estuary Restoration Project ESRP* (18-1587). The minimum match required for this ESRP grant is \$428,572 (30% of the ESRP + Match cost) which is fulfilled by the ALEA funding.
- b) Lake Washington/Cedar/Sammamish Watershed and **SRFB awarded a total of \$800,000** (\$191,711 of SRFB + \$608,289 of PSAR) to this *Meadowdale Beach Park & Estuary Restoration Project* (18-1259) with a match commitment of \$158,176 which can be fulfilled by the \$71,428 balance of ALEA funding plus \$65,319 of the WWRP Water Access grant, and \$21,429 of Snohomish County funds.
- c) The Recreation and Conservation Funding Board awarded \$604,078 of Washington Wildlife and Recreation Program's (WWRP) Water Access Category funds to Meadowdale Beach Park Access Development (18-1507). This funding requires at least \$604,078 in matching funds, which is fulfilled by \$483,262 of the SRFB grant and \$120,816 of Snohomish County funds.
- d) The Recreation and Conservation Funding Board awarded \$500,000 of Aquatic Land Enhancement Account (ALEA) funds to Meadowdale Beach Park & Estuary Restoration (18-1504). The project application included a total of \$2,389,394 in match from a pending ESRP grant, a pending Salmon grant (18-1259), and Snohomish County Cash/Appropriation. ALEA matching requirements are fulfilled by \$316,738 of SRFB, plus the \$1M ESRP grant, plus \$538,759 of the WWRP Water Access funding which reduces the required Snohomish County funding to \$533,897.
- 2) ALEA and WWRP-WA require local match sourced from non-state non-federal funds be at least 10% of the total Project Agreement budget. Total Sponsor Match is \$704,713 which is 20% of the total project agreement amount, exceeding the 10% local match requirement.

B. Eligible Scope Activities by Funding Source

- 1) The **Salmon State**, **PSAR**, and **ESRP** funds are for the *Restoration for rearing juvenile Chinook and other salmonids* project elements as outlined in the State Agreement Description, which includes relocating recreational infrastructure out of the restoration area. This funding is also eligible to be used for a portion of the BNSF Railroad bridge construction, if needed. However, county funds and a Federal Highways Administration grant are expected to be sufficient to afford RR bridge construction, and therefore, it is expected that the RR bridge element will be amended out of the scope once the project is complete.
- 2) The ALEA funding is eligible for restoration costs and park improvements.
- 3) While habitat restoration elements are eligible for reimbursement with **WWRP-Water Access**, this funding will be used to construct the public access improvements.
